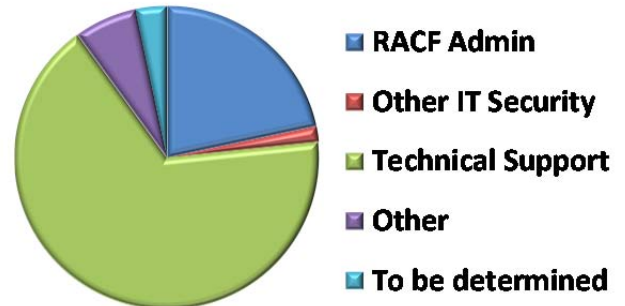


Who has primary responsibility for administering security in your Unix File Systems? This includes changing file owners, changing permission bits, and setting up Access Control Lists.
