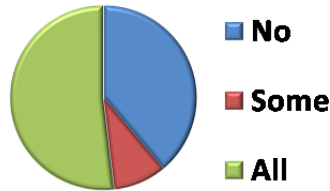


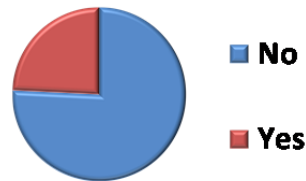
Is the TERMINAL class active in your production z/OS systems?

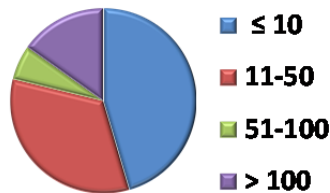
Is the SETROPTS TERMINAL universal access option set to NONE on any systems?

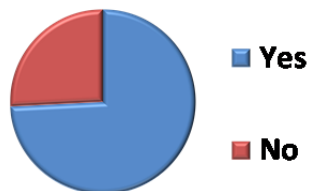

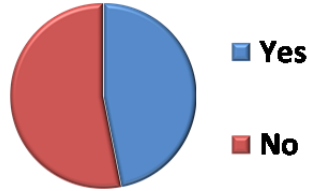
Is the TERMINAL class RACLISTed on most systems where it is active?

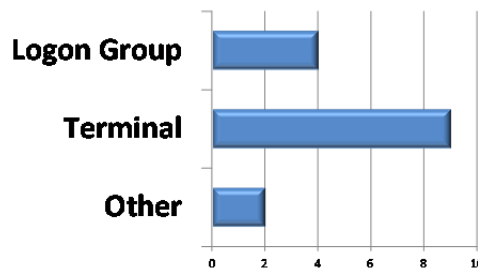
