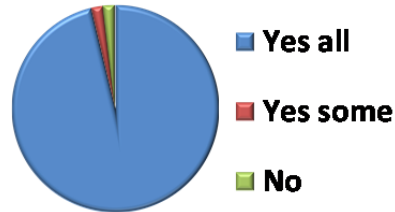


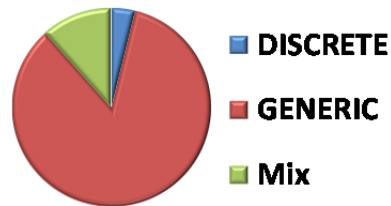
Do you use STARTED profiles to assigned IDs to Started Tasks?

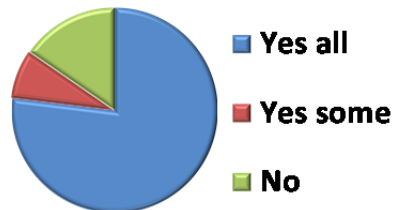
How do you define most STARTED profiles?

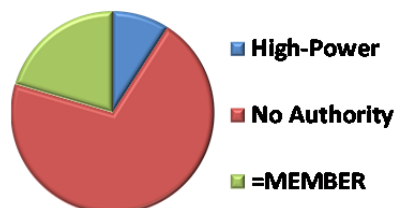
Do you have a catch-all profile such as * .* or ** ?

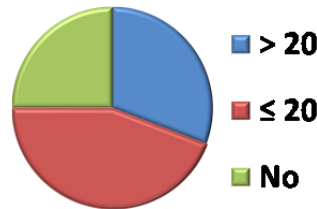
How would you best describe the ID the catch-all profile assigns?

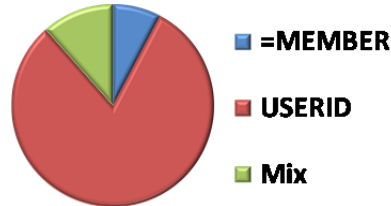
Other than the catch-all profile, do you use masking characters in the first qualifier of any STARTED profiles (e.g., CICS*.*)?

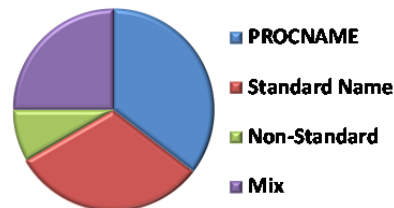
In assigning IDs to Started Tasks in the STDATA segments of your STARTED profiles, which do you use most often?

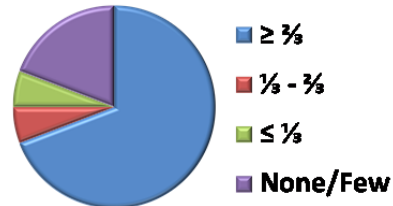
For the specific IDs you assign to Started Tasks, which do you use most often?
